Our Opponent

After losing to Louisville by over 30 points just over a month ago, UCONN is playing their best basketball going into North Texas. Led by Senior guard Shabazz Napier, who is averaging 23 ppg in the tournament, up from his 18 ppg during the regular season. Connecticut isn't a very strong team, but they are long and athletic so Florida must keep them off the glass and win the game inside the paint.

The Huskies are a very dangerous team in transition and create a lot of offense off of turnovers; their bigs run the floor very well for lay-ups. If they aren't able to get out into transition, look for UCONN to run multiple pindowns and pick & rolls to get Napier and Boatright in isolation and two-man game situations.

Keys to Win

1. Wear them down with our constant pressure
 - A. Continued sense of urgency on closeouts & rotations
2. BOX OUT! They thrive on offensive rebounds
3. Limit turnovers - Uconn guards have quick hands on defense
4. Understand personnel - Nothing easy for Napier / Boatright
5. Utilize our size & strength inside on both ends of the floor
